
Pot/kettle holders for beginners (crochet)



Yarn/needle: I prefer yarns with 100% cotton, usually for needle size 3,5-4 (US 4-6).

1. Make a row of chain stitches, 50 or so will do.



2. Keep going back and forth with the double stitch (US: single stitch).



- 3. Combine different colors for the striped pattern of your desire.
- 4. That's all folks!

Tip: I always try to crochet in the loose ends as I go, just line them up along the way as you're crocheting on, and they'll be hidden and tucked away safely.

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
